## America Following the Path of ANCIENT ISRAEL

**T**here is a phrase that goes: “those who fail to learn from the past, are doomed to make the mistakes of the past.” This is especially true for America and the condition we find ourselves in with the Nuclear agreement with Iran. Without ever knowing it, by entering into this agreement, we suddenly find ourselves in the same condition as Ancient Israel just before a foreign nation destroyed them. What have we missed and how did we get here?

You have to wonder how a nation that goes from the shining beacon of the world, a nation of wealth and prosperity filled with blessings after blessings, to a nation grasping in the dark for direction? A nation filled with violence and evil, straddled with debt beyond what we could ever repay, a nation that was established on the principles of God to a nation that has rejected God. The condition America finds itself in, is the same condition that Ancient Israel and the nation of Judah found themselves in just before they came to their demise and removal into captivity.

Finding the reasons doesn't take a great deal of effort. God has left us a trail that is clearly laid out through His Holy Word. The New Testament reveals that of all the past failures were left for us so that we won't make the same mistakes. “Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.” (I Cor 10:11)

Every nation that ever existed that grew to great power and influence believed they were impervious to failure. America is no different. Every nation believed they will always be able to overcome whatever comes its way, and will always exist. The problem is, they all failed to take into account the living laws established from creation that govern the laws of blessings and cursings. Thus, they ignore the warnings of God: “*When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which he hath given thee. Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day.*”

As Israel increased in goods, and wealth, they turned their backs on God and evil set in. They began to substitute laws and customs that were opposed to God's ways. Despite the warnings from the Eternal, with each step of the removal of God, greater punishments would come. God told them they would. Regardless, Israel ignored the warnings, just as America is doing today.

“*But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee: Cursed shalt thou be in the city, and cursed shalt thou be in the field.*” (Deut 28:15-16)

If they still refused to return to God, greater punishments would come: “*And if ye will not yet for all this hearken unto me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins. And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass.*” (Deut 28:)

With each new punishment, Israel would seek to find solutions from everywhere but from God. Eventually other nations would rise up and begin to attack the nation in their weakened condition. Even then Israel wouldn't return to God, but instead, they would turn to the nations for protection and security. *You boast, We have entered into a covenant with death, with the realm of the dead we have made an agreement. When an overwhelming scourge sweeps by, it cannot touch us, for we have made a lie our refuge and falsehood our hiding place.*” (Isa 28:15)

God told them: *And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it.*” (Isa 28:18)

I'm concluding the article here with a question for you to research, a riddle so to speak. Why was the timing of the signing of the agreement the worst possible thing that America could ever have done? While you seek the answer, I'll be preparing to share the answer at the Feast this year in my sermon; The Biblical Mystery of Tammuz 17 and America.

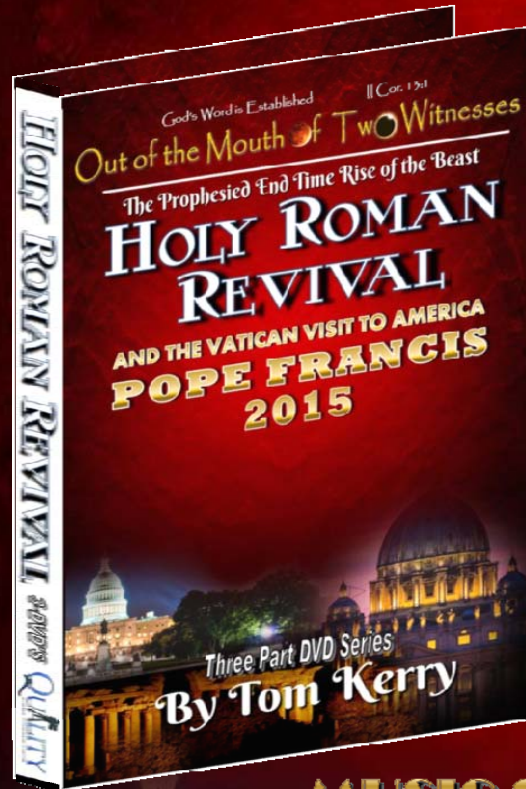
